## DID YOU KNOW...

### Compressor v 3 way Refrigerators

Compressor refrigerators draw a low 12 V current and with reliable solar packs now available they are also a suitable choice for free camping, along with the 3 way gas operated fridge. The battery life will depend on many factors eg the battery size, ambient temperature and how many solar panels are fitted. Also compressor refrigerators will operate up to 30 degrees out of level and perform equally well in hot climates.



An **'RV Friendly Town'** is one that happily provides amenities and services for the mobile traveller. including:

- access to medical and pharmacy services,
- parking within close proximity to general shopping area with groceries & fresh produce,
- service centre for basic vehicle repairs,

- provision of short term (24/48/72 hr) parking within 2.5km of town centre,
- provision of longer term parking within 5-10km of town centre, at a reasonable rate,
- Council to provide one person as contact,

### NSW GOVERNMENT MAKES CARAVANNING DREAM A CHEAPER REALITY

Caravans and camper trailers in NSW will be around \$1,000 cheaper as of July 1, 2009 thanks to the abolition of Stamp Duty on caravans and camper trailers announced in Tuesday's NSW State Budget. Mr Baillie said the \$1,000 savings would now give buyers in NSW the opportunity to spend more on their travels.
